Notice is hereby given that the Board of Commissioners of Williamson County Emergency Services District No. 12 will hold their monthly meeting on **Tuesday, September 8th, 2020, at 6:00 p.m.**, at 2114 Downing Lane, Leander, Texas, for the following purposes.

**Due to the state of emergency and/or local disaster caused by the COVID-19 pandemic, the Board of Commissioners of Williamson County Emergency Services District No. 12 may hold its meeting via telephone conference call because of the difficulty and risks of convening a quorum in one location. If initiated, the call will be broadcast at the meeting location and recorded as required by the Texas Open Meetings Act. In the event the meeting is held via a telephone conference call, the public will be able to participate in person at the meeting location.**

1) Call meeting to order;

2) Public Comment: In accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, any response to a public comment that is made on an item that is not on the published final agenda will be limited to a statement of factual information or a statement of existing policy given in response to the public comment. Any deliberation or decision by the Board must be limited to a proposal to place the subject on a future agenda. Individual members of the public may address the Board for a maximum of three minutes on items not on the current agenda. Additionally, individual members of the public may address the Board for a maximum of three minutes per person per agenda item. Individuals may address the Board once per item. Members of the public will speak on an agenda item after comments on the item is called for by the presiding officer, but before Board discussion and consideration of the item.

- 12) Authorize posting of statement regarding adopted tax rate to home page of District website;
- 13) Discuss investigation into potential District sales tax collection, to include whether a May election may be needed (for sales tax, annexation, tax rate, bonds, etc.);
